YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO JOIN OUR TOURS:

If you have a cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, runny nose, fever or if you are awaiting results from being tested for COVID-19.

Our guides carry a QR code to scan if you use the NZ COVID-tracer app.

When you place a booking you will be asked for the names of everyone in your group, and the contact phone number of the lead person. *This information will be entered on our Contract Tracing Register and is collected to assist in the management and contact tracing of COVID-19. It will be given to the Ministry of Health and/or the district health board on request if it is required for contact tracing purposes. It will not be used for any other purpose and will be destroyed after 30 days.*

You will be required to sanitise your hands before boarding the water taxi to Ulva Island and before entering our vehicle for kiwi spotting.

High touch surfaces will be disinfected on the water taxi and our vehicle between each trip.

Mask wearing is ESSENTIAL when travelling by water taxi to Ulva Island AND when convening at the wharf prior to boarding.

Mask wearing is ESSENTIAL when travelling in our vehicle for kiwi spotting.

The water taxi operator has a QR code available to scan if you use the NZ COVID-tracer app. *We have agreed to share our contact tracing register with the water taxi operator if it is required, as all businesses must have an alternative method aside from the phone app.*

Even though our tours take place outdoors we STRONGLY RECOMMEND you wear a mask.

We appreciate that it can be difficult to hear someone speaking with a mask on and therefore our guide may remove their mask during the tour; if you are uncomfortable with this please speak with the guide privately before the tour begins or let our office know.

Group size will be limited to a maximum of two 'bubbles' per one of our guides in order that distance can be maintained between people you don't know.

The Ministry of Business, Innovation & Employment has advised that increased spacing between people travelling on the water taxi to/from Ulva Island is not necessary.

If you have an exemption from mask wearing, please let us know at the time of placing a booking. *We respect your privacy and ask that you respect others by maintaining your distance. By informing us that you are exempt from mask wearing prior to the tour, means we can advise those that we come into contact with and avoid you being questioned publicly about the lack of mask.*
